Instructions for signing your Codicil

- 1 Obtain two witnesses, they must not be:
 - Beneficiaries under your Will or Codicil
 - Their Wives or Husbands
 - Executors

YOU MUST ALL THREE BE PRESENT WHEN THE CODICIL IS SIGNED AND WITNESSED

- 2 Sign your name in ink where indicated at the end of the Codicil. Use your normal signature.
- 3 The witnesses must sign where shown and add clearly their full names, address and preferably their occupations.
- 4 Do not attach anything to your Codicil; for example, do not attach paperclips or pins as this may cause difficulties in proving your Will on your death with the Probate registry.
- 5. It is vital that all formalities are properly observed otherwise your Codicil may be invalid.
